### Guest Speaker

Steve Cunningham

Steve is the President of the State Universities Annuitants Association Board of Directors.

Steve will speak about Brian Soady, the new Executive Director for SUAA, , why SUAA/CDAA membership is important, and the issues before SUAA.

Steven Cunningham, EdD, has 25 years of service in SURS. Following several years of work as a Journeyman Electrician, Steve started his higher education career with the Illinois Board of Regents, where he served as Assistant Vice Chancellor for HR until 1993 when he joined NIU as their first Director of Human Resources. Steve served in several roles at NIU before retiring in 2015 as NIU's long-term Vice President of Administration. Thereafter, he relocated to Pensacola, FL, where he served as Vice President for Administration and CFO with the University of West Florida, until fully retiring in 2019. Throughout his career in Illinois higher education, Steve was honored to participate as a member of the administrative team representing higher education in the Illinois State Legislature with respect to SURS participant benefits, business regulations, and funding for higher education.
